A **comedy** is a show that tries to be funny and make you laugh.


**Allotments** are small areas of land that you can rent to grow plants.

**Nature** includes plants, animals and rivers.




Then we will use different materials to turn one drawing into an art piece together.

We want our festival to be accessible. Accessible means everyone can get to our festival and enjoy the activities and shows.


